This cause coming on to be heard and being heard on January 7, 2009 before the undersigned Superior Court Judge on the plaintiffs' Motion to Amend and to Add Parties. The matter was heard by consent of all parties in the Superior Court of Guilford County, High Point Division, the undersigned having agreed upon the consent of the parties to retain jurisdiction of the action.

UPON REVIEW of the motion pending, the pleadings in this matter, the parties' briefs, and the file contents, and having entertained the arguments of counsel for the parties, the Court finds that good cause exists to allow plaintiffs to amend their complaint and to add parties-defendant as requested in their motion.

It is, therefore, hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that plaintiffs' Motion to Amend and to Add Parties should be and hereby is GRANTED. The Amended Complaint, attached hereto as Exhibit A, shall be deemed filed as of the date of this Order. When they obtain the identities of the new defendants, plaintiffs shall be entitled to file an Amended Complaint, identifying the new defendants by name in accordance with N.C.G.S. § 1-166, without further leave of Court. The existing defendants, having already filed Answers to the original Complaint, shall be required to file no further responsive pleading.
